Prayers of Agreement

“Truly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything they ask, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them.” Matthew 18:18-20 (ESV)

The power of God is released when we come into agreement with Him.

Over the next few minutes as you spend time in worship and reflection during Holy Communion we invite you to pray these prayers of agreement with God's Word over your life, marriage, singleness, family, and finances.

My Life

Lord, today I believe your word is true and stand in agreement that by faith, I have been saved by your everlasting gift of grace (Ephesians 2:8). I have been renewed in you from my past transgressions and I am no longer a slave to sin (Romans 6:6). Father, because of my confidence in you, I do not fear anyone (Psalm 118:6) because I am made in your image (Genesis 1:27). I am your masterpiece (Psalm 139:14) and greatness will follow me all of my days. When trouble arises against me, I find comfort in your peace (John 16:33) because you love me deeply and I am considered one of your precious servants (Romans 1:7). In Jesus Name, Amen.

My Finances/Business

Father, I take command of my finances/business today. I believe that my steps are established by you in all my endeavors (Proverbs 16:9). Align me with Godly and knowledgeable individuals who are willing to share their wisdom. I will not focus on where my financial freedom may start (Zechariah 4:10) but trust and know that favor is mine in whatever I put my hands to (Psalm 90:17). I boldly confess that I lead a debt-free life and exemplify a spirit of love to whomever I encounter (Romans 13:8). For we realize we are on the same team, both ambassadors of your kingdom (2 Corinthians 5:20). My Children

Father, I come into agreement with your word over my child/children...that if I train them up in the way they should go, when they are old they will not depart from it (Proverbs 22:6). Lord, I thank you that my child/children are taught of you and have a healthy relationship with you for themselves. I thank you for helping me to identify the gifts you've placed in my child(ren) so that they might walk in their purpose early on. I thank you that they are above what may be defined as average and excel in everything they set their minds to do (Philippians 4:13). I praise you that they are leaders and do not succumb to peer pressure. I declare that they walk in integrity. I thank you that they do not have a spirit of fear but of power, love and a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:7). Lord, I thank you that my child(ren) respect authority and are peacemakers which makes them blessed and called Children of God (Matt 5:9). Thank you Lord for protecting and keeping them in your hands. In Jesus Name, Amen.

Please, take over my mind when I feel alone, betrayed, hurt or discouraged and replace my despair with thoughts that are true, noble, and gracious. Lord, keep my mind on the best things, not the worst things; and think only on things that glorify and praise you (Phil 4:8).

Lord, please forgive me for any bitterness or frustration I've been holding inside because of my situation or my past. Thank you for covering me in every season of my life; through successes and deep sorrow (1Thess 5:18). Thank you for grace, mercy, guidance, and deliverance in my life. Thank you for my salvation and the peace you have provided to me as a member of your body (Colossians 3:15). Lord, thank you for the singleness in which you have called me to walk in this moment until your defined and divine time shows another way. For your way is perfect and flawless, and I will cover myself in you (Psalm 18:30). In Jesus Name, Amen.

Love over Hate and Prejudice

Lord, forgive me of all unjust thoughts and actions I've committed towards Your people (my family) in Christ and those who do not have a relationship with You. I repent of my old ways of thinking and casting judgment, for Your word says those who judge others condemn themselves (Romans 2:1). Jesus, I desire to renew my relationship with You. Please restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit to sustain my commitment to You (Psalm 51:12).

Lord, by faith I receive my restoration and salvation. I rely on the love that You have for me. You are love (1 John 4:8). Today, I choose to live in love and in You. Therefore, I know Your love abides in me. (1 John 4:16). So, fill me up Lord. I want to align my love for others with Your Word. Daily, remind me of Your Word that says above all, love each other deeply, because love covers a multitude of sins. (1 Peter 4:8).

Lord, please restore my sight. Remove me from the blinding darkness caused by hate and discrimination (1 John 2:11). Let Your light shine through me as a vessel of reconciliation, that crosses multiple barriers and boundaries for Your glory. Thank You for my renewed mind and spirit. Thank You for purifying me and allowing me to walk in Your Ways (Psalm 51:10). Thank You for the one and only Spirit that baptizes all people, from all backgrounds, of all ethnicities, and redeems all sin that set us free (1 Corinthians 12:13). In Jesus Name, Amen.
