Job Title: Musician (*Keyboardist-Instrumental Worshiper*)

Department: Worship Ministry

At The Worship Center Christian Church, worship is more than the music before a sermon. Worship happens beyond the walls of the church every day. The responsibility of the ***Musician (Instrumental Worshiper)*** is to lead others to live their lives like the lyrics of a song, continually praising God for His love and goodness

Purpose of the Job:

- The role of the ***Musician (Instrumental Worshiper)*** is to collaborate with the Worship Pastor, and/or his/her designee, in assisting with cultivating a life giving, passionate and skillful culture of worship at The Worship Center Christian Church. This is accomplished through musical leadership, preparedness and partnerships of Staff and TWC Dream Team Worship members and others as assigned by the Worship Pastor to include TWC Youth Worshipers.

Experience and Knowledge Required:

- Proficient in designated instrument with the ability to read music as well as play by ear.
- Previous band experience within the local church/ministry.
- Ability to handle multiple projects effectively.
- Ability to assist in creating, coordinating and leading a worship experience with a team.
- Excellent verbal and interpersonal skills.
- Proficiency in Word, Excel and Power Point.
- Ability to learn and use Planning Center Online software.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- Instrumentalist at all TWC services and activities. These services may include, but are not limited to, (*Sunday morning, Saturday Prayer, Funerals, Bible Study, Special events.*)
- Assist as needed in the planning and implementation of the music and instrumentals.
- Assist as needed in the training and coordination of TWC Worship band team members.
- Assist, as needed the Worship Pastor with department planning and implementation of projects.
- Assist Dream Teamers desiring to go through the process of becoming a member of the Worship Team.
- Assist in the care of the TWC Worship Dream Team.
- Participate and help accomplish major TWC projects and department goals.

Other Duties and Responsibilities:

- Consistent and timely attendance at all Worship Team rehearsals.
- Consistent and timely attendance at all TWC services.
- Present and visible (in the sanctuary) at all services
- All other duties as assigned.

 - i. The true measure of leadership is how you disciple others. TWC's commitment to the Great Commission involves you. You should be intentional about identifying and developing other Dream Teamers and potential TWC Team members to serve in your department
